2008 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE

NOTE: *Applications must be submitted directly to The PinkRose Foundation and all decisions of the PinkRose Foundation are final and binding.*

Eligibility Requirements: Eligibility is limited to individuals who are legal residents of the United States of America, under the age of 25 who have lost a parent or legal guardian to breast cancer. Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Applicants must be pursuing post secondary education or certificate training.

Written Statement

A written statement must be submitted with your Application. In your statement, you should address the topics outlined below. Please include your name and the name of your deceased parent in the right-hand corner on the pages of the statement. This statement should total not more than two pages and should have a picture.

1. Autobiographical information describing the significant impact of breast cancer in your life. Also describe how your academic motivation and interests, professional and volunteer experience, and career objectives were altered. Include a summary of your principal interests and activities. Please highlight activities that are community- and/or service-oriented and those in which you have held leadership positions.
2. A detailed statement of intent articulating your interest in the PinkRose Scholarship. Please include explanations of how obtaining a post-secondary degree or certificate will benefit your future by helping to fulfill your goals and dreams.

Applicant's Agreement

If I receive a PinkRose Foundation Scholarship, I agree that:

1. I am responsible for gaining admission at my selected institution and if my scholarship has been approved by The PinkRose Foundation Selection Panel then I will use my scholarship only at my selected institution;
2. My scholarship studies can begin no earlier than 1 January 2009,
3. I am expected to embrace PinkRose's spirit of volunteerism and engage in volunteer activities in my local community and at my college;
4. To promote the PinkRose Foundation wherever possible and to permit The PinkRose Foundation to use my name and all photographs and written reports generated through any of my activities related to my scholarship;
5. I am responsible for any taxes or other costs associated with receipt of the scholarship; and
6. My application is subject to the Scholarship Terms and Conditions of Participation, and I acknowledge that nothing will be returned to me and the PinkRose Foundation owns my Application and any submissions.

2008 PINKROSE SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

In order to be eligible to participate and be considered for a PinkRose Scholarship your ("Applicant") Application must be accompanied by a signed and dated Acknowledgment.

Terms and Conditions of Participation:

1. No purchase Necessary. Open to legal residents of the 50 United States, and/or the District of Columbia, who are at least 18 years of age and under 25 years of age and who have lost a parent or legal guardian to breast cancer. To submit a Scholarship Application, please complete the current PinkRose Scholarship Application. No Applications will be considered without a completed Application and a signed Acknowledgment, signifying your understanding and agreement with these Scholarship Terms and Conditions of Participation. Send the Application, written essay, this signed Acknowledgment, a copy of your parent's or legal guardian's death certificate with breast cancer identified as the cause of death, a copy of your birth certificate, and proof of enrollment in your selected institution (collectively referred to as "Application Materials") to the following address: *The PinkRose Foundation P.O. Box 4025, Dedham, MA 02027.*

2. PinkRose Foundation directors, employees and their immediate families may not participate in this Scholarship Program. Applicant submitting the Application Materials must be acting on behalf of themselves, and if necessary, with the consent of a legal guardian. Applicants must provide current contact information in order to be notified in the event that their Application is selected and they are awarded a PinkRose Scholarship for either the calendar or academic year following the calendar year that that the Application was submitted (as determined by the PinkRose Foundation in its sole discretion).

3. All PinkRose scholarships are valid for up to the total scholarship amount identified in the formal notice of PinkRose Scholarship award from The PinkRose Foundation. PinkRose Scholarship awards are valid only for the calendar or academic year following the calendar year that the Application Materials were submitted and cannot be carried on to subsequent calendar or academic years. Applications for each PinkRose Scholarship award period are accepted during the period beginning on June 1st, and ending on August 31st of each calendar year. PinkRose Scholarships shall be awarded during October of each year and are valid for the following calendar year only. For each annual enrollment Application period as defined herein, all Applications must be received not later than 5:00 PM EST on August 31st, however, if such day falls on a non-business day, then applications will be received until 5:00 PM EST on the first business day following August 31st. A panel of judges selected by the PinkRose foundation will review Applications, whose decision on all matters shall be final. PinkRose Scholarship recipients will be notified during the month of October by the means specified in these Scholarship Terms and Conditions of Participation.

4. Applicants who have been selected to receive a PinkRose Scholarship will be notified by first class mail. Odds of being selected for a PinkRose Scholarship depends upon the number of valid Applications received. Recipients will be posted at the PinkRose Web Site within 30 days of selecting all of the recipients for that year. Winners may be asked to submit a short biography and/or photograph of himself/herself that will be posted to the PinkRose Web Site.

5. Only one Application per Applicant. Except where expressly prohibited by law, participation in the PinkRose Scholarship Program represents your express acknowledgment and agreement that the

6. All Application Materials received within the Application submission period identified in Paragraph 3 above will be reviewed before being posted to the PinkRose Website.

7. Only Application Materials that are complete and properly submitted will be considered by the PinkRose Foundation. No Applicant will be denied a PinkRose Scholarship based upon gender, race, religion, sexual preference, or any other illegal basis for granting or denying a PinkRose Scholarship award. Selection of applications for PinkRose Scholarship will be done annually based upon the panel's determination and may include selection on a first come first served basis, best essay, and/or other non-discriminatory means as selected by the panel, in the panel's sole discretion.

8. The amount of each PinkRose Scholarship and the total number of PinkRose Scholarships granted depends upon the funds available and number of applicants on a year to year basis. The PinkRose Foundation reserves the right in its sole discretion to establish the PinkRose Scholarship amounts and number of PinkRose Scholarship awards in each calendar year, if any. Award of PinkRose Scholarships are limited and Applicants may only receive up to one PinkRose Scholarship per calendar year. PinkRose Scholarships are not transferable, may not be substituted and may not be redeemed for cash. Any and all applicable federal, state, local taxes, as well as any other taxes, fines, fees or the like, are the responsibility of the PinkRose Scholarship recipient; however, there are no fees due to the PinkRose Foundation for participating in the PinkRose Scholarship Program.

9. By participating, Applicants agree to release the PinkRose Foundation, its respective subsidiaries and affiliates, directors, employees and agents, and sponsors, from and against any and all liability for any injury or loss caused by or resulting from entry or participation in the PinkRose Scholarship Program, and any related activities or consequences. By acceptance of the PinkRose Scholarship, the recipient warrants and represents that he/she has complied with any notice, authorization or other requirement that may be imposed by law regarding the acceptance or receipt of the PinkRose Scholarship award. The PinkRose Foundation, and its directors, employees, agents, donators, sponsors or the like are not responsible for any lost, misdelivered, incorrect or inaccurate Application Materials, or for any printing, or technical failure of any kind which may occur in the processing, printing, or distribution or reception of Application Materials. The PinkRose Scholarship recipient may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and/or a liability release. The PinkRose Foundation, its directors, employees, donors, and any sponsors reserve the right to disqualify any applicant who has violated the rules and to modify, suspend or terminate the Scholarship Program in the event that it becomes over burdensome, technically corrupted, illegal, or other reason giving rise to the termination of the Scholarship Program. The Scholarship Program is void where restricted or prohibited.

13. This Scholarship Program is subject to the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Applicants agree to the personal jurisdiction of the courts within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating, Applicant agrees to abide by all rules, and agrees to these terms and restrictions as set forth in these Scholarship Terms and Conditions of Participation.
